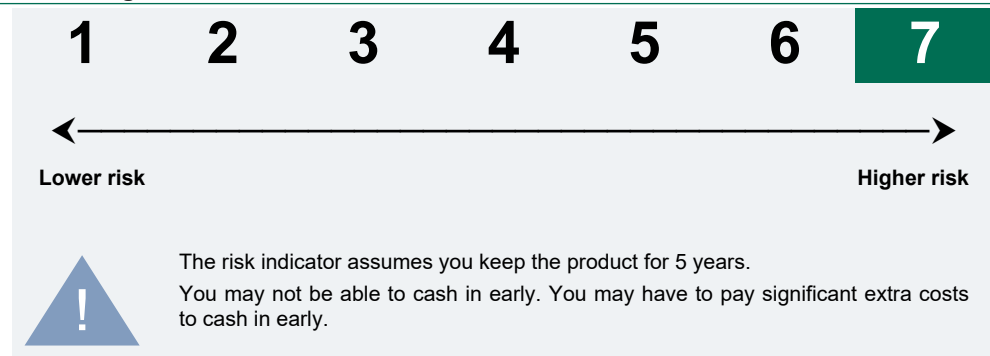
What is this product?

Term	5 years. PRIIP manufacturer is entitled to terminate the PRIIP unilaterally, if you are not complying with initial and variable margin requirements during the term of the product.			
Objectives	Interest Rate Caps are binding agreements under which the buyer receives a compensation payment on the outstanding notional at the end of each calculation period (payment dates) when the reference rate is fixed above the agreed cap rate on the fixing date. In return, the buyer pays an amount of money (option premium) on a pre-agreed date (option premium payment date).

Intended investor: retail investor. This product, Interest Rate Cap, is aimed at retail clients, who are interested in hedging and who have a long term investment horizon of more than 5 years. The Interest Rate Cap is a product for informed investor with average knowledge of and/or experience with financial products. The investor can bear no or only minor losses of the investment amount and puts emphasis on capital protection.

What are the risks and what could I get in return?

Risk indicator



The summary risk indicator is a guide to the level of risk of this product compared to other products. It shows how likely it is that the product will lose money because of movements in the markets or because we are not able to pay you.

We have classified this product as 7 out of 7, which is the highest risk class.

This rates the potential losses from future performance at a very high level, and poor market conditions are very unlikely to impact the capacity of OTP Bank to pay you.

Be aware of currency risk. You will receive payments in a different currency, so the final return you will get will depend on the exchange rate between the two currencies. This risk is not considered in the indicator shown above.

This product does not include any minimum guaranteed return and you could lose some or all or even more than your investment amount.

What you will get from this product depends on future market performance. Market developments in the future are uncertain and cannot be accurately predicted. The scenarios shown are illustrations based on results from the past and on certain assumptions. Markets could develop very differently in the future.

The scenarios shown illustrate how your investment could perform. What are the costs?

The person advising on or selling you this product may charge you other costs. If so, this person will provide you with information about these costs and how they affect your investment.

Costs over time

The tables show the amounts that are taken from your investment to cover different types of costs. These amounts depend on how much you invest and how long you hold the product. The amounts shown here are illustrations based on an example investment amount and different possible investment periods.

We have assumed:

- In the first year you would get back the amount that you invested (0 % annual return). For the other holding periods we have assumed the product performs as shown in the moderate scenario.
- EUR 10,000 is invested.

How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

Recommended holding period: This product is designed to be held to the agreed 5 years date in order to match your investment requirement.

Under extreme market conditions you may not be able to cash in early, and you may have to pay significant extra costs to cash in early. It is a product to be entered into for its term that cannot be easily sold. Early termination may occur if certain events of default or other termination events occur (e.g. you are not fulfilling margin requirements), in which case early termination payments may apply. Early exit impact: If the product is terminated early, in whole or in part, an Early Termination Payment may become payable by either you or OTP Bank. The Early Termination Payment is linked to market parameters and could be a substantial loss or gain to you. Settlement on early termination will be specific to your Interest Rate Cap and will be influenced by a number of factors which include but are not limited to: whether it is an increasing or decreasing interest rate environment; the movement of the interest rates since the trade date; the amount affected by the early termination.

The Early Termination Payment amount represents the economic value of what OTP Bank would have paid or received if the product continued as agreed.
